



Gas information notice Fee changes July 2010

Following consultation with industry the ACT Planning and Land Authority (ACTPLA) has made a number of changes to the gas fee structure for 2010–2011.

1. The fee structure for new commercial work, megajoule loading for gas meters has been expanded to include a new level of 0 to 500.

| Megajoule loading scale per meter | Fee structure |
|-----------------------------------|---|
| 0-500 | Level 1 see ACTPLA fees and charges booklet |
| 501-900 | Level 2 see ACTPLA fees and charges booklet |

2. For commercial kitchens or laundries the fee level has been expanded lowering the fees for small jobs (see below).

Commercial kitchen or laundry including 2 Type A appliances (level 1 base fee applies).

Commercial kitchen or laundry more than 3-6 Type A appliances (level 2 fee applies)
Type A appliance in excess of 6 an additional fee applies to each appliance.

New gas commencement notices and certificate of compliance booklets are now available from ACTPLA Mitchell Office.

There are three gas booklets:

- commencement notice and certificate of compliance for gasfitting work,
- commencement notice and certificate of compliance for gasfitting work to multi-unit developments
- notification and certificate of compliance for minor works.

Note:

A new class of inspection — **existing occupied residential home (new gas meter)** — has been added. .

If the gasfitter ticks this box ACTPLA will arrange the inspection with the home owner. (This only applies to new gasfitting work on existing occupied residential homes where a new gas service with a meter is installed).

Additional gasfitting work to replace, extend or modify the consumer piping system to a class 1 building or structure and/or associated 10a structure plus meter upgrades a Minor Works certificate and fee is applied.
